## **Criminal Justice Collection**

Library database which includes articles from scholarly and general interest magazines on justice, forensics, crime and punishment. Use Advanced Search function to search by "Subject."

## **LegalTrac**

Library database which includes a wide range of legal topics in the form of: major law reviews, legal newspapers, bar association journals, and international legal journals. Use Advanced Search function to search by "Subject."

## **Canadian Point of View**

Library database that provides multiple viewpoints on over 200 current issues, such as the environment, human rights, and prison conditions. Search by topic and browse opposing articles on controversial topics.

## **Canadian Legal Information Institution (CANLII) – <http://www.canlii.org>**

Provides access to court judgments, tribunal decisions, statutes, regulations, and commentary from all Canadian jurisdictions. You can easily search by keyword (such as "Wrongful Conviction" or "Prison Regulations"). You can also access important legal documents such as the Criminal Code or the Income Tax Act.

A detailed summary of all the provincial laws currently in effect for Ontario. You can browse laws alphabetically or search specific terms.
